



DMCC recommends member companies use the following opt-in clauses: If any dispute, claim, controversy or difference between the [Parties] arises out of or in connection with this [Agreement], including any question regarding its existence, validity, interpretation or termination (Dispute), then the [Parties] will attempt to settle it by mediation in accordance with the DMCC Disputes Centre Mediation Rules (Mediation Rules), which rules are deemed to be incorporated by reference into this clause. If the Dispute is not resolved within thirty (30) days after a [Party] has made a written request for mediation (Request) in accordance with the Mediation Rules or either [Party] fails to participate or ceases to participate in the mediation within thirty (30) days after a [Party] has made a Request, then the [Parties] agree that the courts of the Dubai International Financial Centre shall have exclusive jurisdiction to finally determine the Dispute.
